1. Indians are welcoming President Trump with all the affection and warmth they accord to certain very special guests. According such spectacular welcome to special guests is ingrained in the Indian culture.
2. Prime Minister Modi has invited President Trump to Ahmedabad in his home state of Gujarat to kickstart or one can say inaugurate his visit to India. The invitation and its acceptance is a strong indication of the personal rapport and chemistry that the two leaders have built over the years.

Inaugurating new projects or new venues (the Cricket Stadium in Motera, Ahmedabad in this case) is considered very auspicious in Indian culture and is an honor given to very special guests, The fact that Prime Minister Modi on behalf of the Indian people has accorded this honor to President Trump and the fact that President Trump has accepted this honor augurs very auspicious for the bilateral relationship.
